PROJECT

Please submit a project in Landscape Design or Landscape Architecture. These may be created for the scholarship competition or may be projects submitted for academic coursework. The submitted project does not need to be a part of this year's work but should have been completed after the applicant has spent 12 credit hours in the curriculum. No group projects will be accepted.

Materials submitted should include a written summary (not to exceed 500 words) and photo / graphic presentations (maximum 3) of the project. Make sure that the name of the applicant is not visible anywhere on the project.

A committee of landscape architects from the Oklahoma Chapter will be judging the submitted projects. The projects will be judged on the following items:

1. Ability of written word and / or graphics to clearly convey the project purpose and goal.
2. Verbal statement and / or graphic schematic of the applicant's process used to achieve the final design to fulfill the goals of the project.
3. Graphic rendition of the project's final design.
4. Neat graphics at a readable scale that enable a clear understanding of the project. If photos are used, provide good quality photos that allow proper readability.

Required Attachments: This list supersedes the attachment list on Standard Scholarship Application Form Part A.

- Transcript: Please submit an official transcript of all collegiate studies.
- Letter of reference: Please submit a letter from an instructor for the required credits in landscape design / landscape architecture.
- Consent and Release Form (Part A, page 2).
