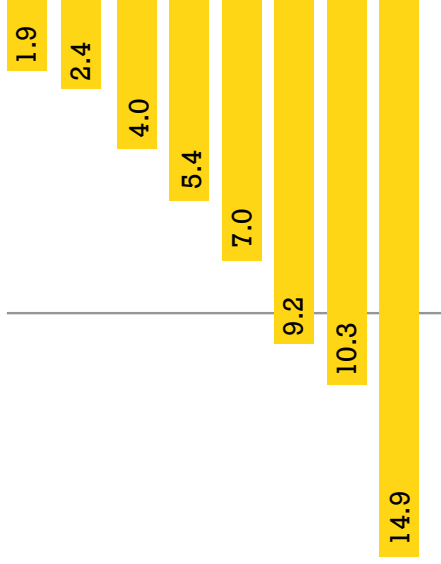

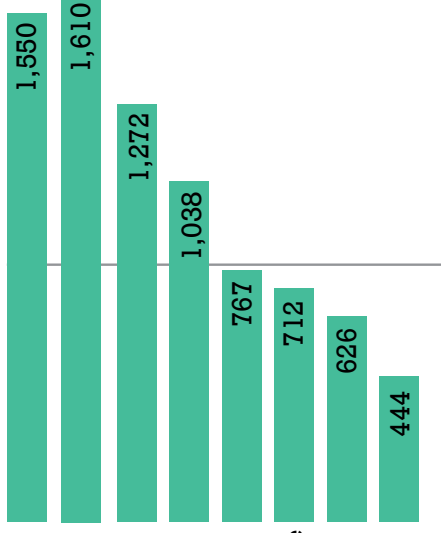
Adults with a college degree earn about 84% more than adults with only a high school diploma.
